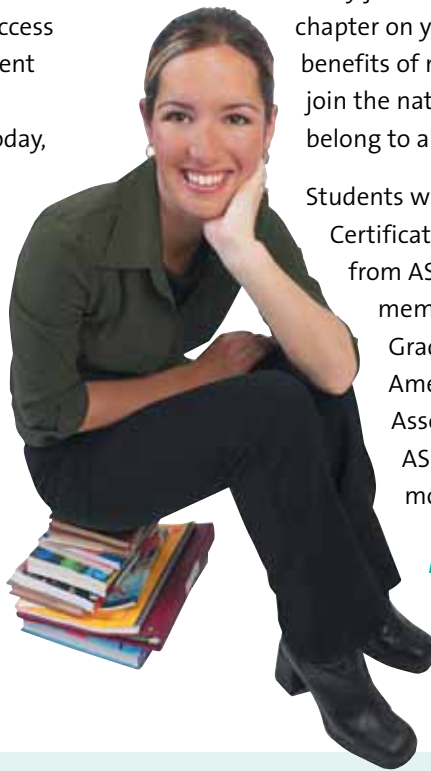
Who's eligible?

- The National Student Speech Language Hearing Association was founded in 1972. Known as NSSLHA (pronounced “niss-luh”), it's a pre-professional association for graduate and undergraduate students interested in the study of communication sciences and disorders.
- NSSLHA is the only official national student association recognized by the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association (ASHA). It gives you ASHA-related benefits and discounts as well as those exclusive to NSSLHA.
- NSSLHA has about 13,000 members and more than 300 local chapters in colleges and universities. While our name begins with “National” and our headquarters are in the U.S., we have a large number of international members.
